An electronic device is a thing that uses electricity to do something useful. Examples include phones, computers, and TVs. They have tiny parts inside that work together to make them do different jobs, like showing pictures or playing music.

Some examples of electronic products include smartphones, laptops, tablets, televisions, digital cameras, MP3 players, game consoles, fitness trackers, smartwatches, e-readers, desktop computers, headphones, portable speakers, GPS devices, drones, Bluetooth earbuds, virtual reality headsets, digital voice recorders, home security cameras, smart thermostats, wearable health monitors, action cameras, projectors, keyboards, graphic tablets, coffee makers with digital displays, robot vacuums, electric toothbrushes, Wi-Fi routers, smart lighting systems, digital photo frames, electric shavers, portable power banks, digital watches, scales, car GPS navigation systems, handheld game consoles, wireless charging pads, 3D printers, and smart refrigerators.

Smart devices are products that can do more than regular electronic devices because they can connect to the internet and sometimes to other devices. They can be controlled or monitored using a phone or computer. Examples include smartwatches, smart TVs, and smart thermostats.

The most popular electronic device is the smartphone. In America, more than 85% of the total population owns a smartphone. In Korea, around 94% of the total population owns a smartphone. The majority of the people who live in developed country owns a smartphone, which makes it the most common electronic device.

In daily life, people frequently use products like smartphones, laptops, tablets, televisions, digital watches, fitness trackers, microwaves, refrigerators, coffee makers, electric toothbrushes, washing machines, headphones, smartwatches, game consoles, and alarm clocks.

One of the earliest electrical appliances was the electric toaster. In 1893, Crompton & Company of Chelmsford, Essex, introduced the Eclipse, the first electric toaster. This means that electric toasters have been around for over 130 years! Iron, fan, and vacuum cleaner were also some of the early electric appliances.
