AGM batteries are the best car batteries for vehicles with auto start-stop engines because they can deliver deep power and still start a car engine

3. Lithium-Ion Batteries: Some modern vehicles like Tesla, Peugeot, Hyundai, Honda, BMW, Toyota, Volkswagen, and Volvo are equipped with lithium-ion batteries, which have a longer lifespan, often exceeding 3 years. These batteries are lightweight and can withstand frequent deep discharges.

However, did you know? that excessive installation of these accessories can reduce the lifespan of your car's battery. When the engine is off, minimize the use of electrical accessories such as lights, radios,
