

Electric vehicle policy niue

The NEV credit mandate, introduced in 2017, has been a powerful driver of EV sales. It sets annual ZEV credit targets for manufacturers as a percentage of their annual vehicle sales. In 2020, the programme and its targets were extended to 2023, by which the target will be 18% (16% in 2022, 14% in 2021).

Explore key policies and measures for EV deployment. The table highlights current as well as announced key policies and measures that support the deployment of electric vehicles (EVs) and zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs) by region and country.

Typical policies include fuel economy and pollutant standards; zero-emission vehicle mandates; economic and budgetary regulation for fuels and vehicles, such as through fiscal regimes and taxation; purchase incentives and subsidies; and bans on internal combustion engine (ICE)-only vehicles.

This roadmap represents a whole-of-government approach to addressing the energy security challenges of Niue which looks at the energy sector as a whole - electricity, renewable energy, energy efficiency and petroleum - and is supported by development partners for its implementation.

It must be noted that the country has two remarkable features: 1) Niue has achieved 100% electricity penetration and all 14 villages spread throughout the island are grid connected; and 2) the 2 Niue Intended Nationally Determined Contributions,
