First, verify that the installer holds all necessary licenses and insurance to operate in your state. Each state has its own licensing requirements for contractors, and you can usually check this information on your state's contractor licensing board website. For example, if you are in California, you can use the Contractors State License Board (CSLB) website to verify a license.

Having the right licenses means the installer meets the legal requirements for electrical and general contracting work, while insurance protects you in case of any accidents or damages during the installation. Don't be shy about asking the company for copies of their licenses and insurance certificates.

We recommend also looking for the company's certification. It can be confusing, as there are more types of certifications, so let's clarify it a bit better in the following overview.
