by the historic building but by two friendly black Labradors named Eric and Florence.

Eric, aged 10, and Florence, aged 9, work as welcomers and belong to Head Verger Chris Skepper.

"They"re very calm and friendly. They are not trained therapy dogs, but Eric and Florence naturally perform

that role. They tend to have a soothing presence on people - visitors have found comfort and joy in simply

sitting and stroking them," Chris said.
