The region sits on the Birmingham Plateau, an upland area that ranges between 150 and 300 meters above sea level. Coal deposits lie underneath layers of sandstone and clay. is situated in the watershed between the Rivers Avon, Trent, and Severn, with access to plenty of freshwaters. Landlocked, the area remained unsettled for centuries. However, the presence of coal, iron, and timber made Birmingham a prime territory for industrial expansion.
